a. Calculating GPA's - use semester or year grades? (Bronwen & Joell)

How Skyward calculates GPA's. JMC calculated GPA's at the end of the year. When we switched to Skyward, it calculates GPA's each semester.

MATH....EXAMPLE

A semester based class has a final grade, so it wouldn't affect the decision. It seems fair to include all their work. Students who are very good in semester 1, but then seem to flounder semester 2. Each teacher will have a different set up for points and grading. The year long calculation seems more fair. There may be certain topics they accel at. It should be based on the final grade for the year. We think that Skyward was set up to do it this way, it was not a decision we made. Going back to past years may or may not be possible to recalculate GPA's. It would be simpler for families to calculate their GPA's. This will not affect the students applying to college during senior year. Is this something that goes to the BOD? Yes, it will be brought to the BOD.

Is Skyward aware of this? Yes, they are helping Joell fix it. If we are fixing an error, do we go back to past years? Joell will see if it is a possibility.
