## High School Progression (New Student Information)

We expect all students and families to understand the course progression at the Math \& Science Academy and the rigor that goes along with these classes. Your child will receive several hours of homework each week for every one of these classes.

## English

Students must have four years of English in the following sequence:

- Literature \& Composition (9 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- British World Literature ( $10^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ grade students must choose 2 full years of the following:
- American Literature - 1 year
- AP Literature and Composition - 1 year
- Composition of Real Life -1 semester and Research Writing -1 semester

## Health and Physical Education

Students must complete the following as a high school requirement:

- Physical Education (9 $9^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 semester
- Health ( $9^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 semester

## Math

Students must be on track to graduate at MSA and pass Calculus to graduate. All new students are required to take a math placement exam. A typical progression during high school looks like this:

- Algebra III ( $9^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Pre-Calculus ( $10^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Calculus ( $11^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Algebra II (9 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Algebra III ( $10^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Pre-Calculus ( $11^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Calculus ( $12^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year

## Science

Students must have the following progression and meet three years of science and pass all classes to graduate:

- Biology ( $9^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Chemistry ( $10^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Physics ( $11^{\text {th }}$ or $12^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year

## Spanish

## Social Studies

Students must have four years of social studies in high school as a graduation requirement. The typical progression is as follows:

- Ancient World History ( $9^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Modern World History ( $10^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- American History ( $11^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 year
- Political Science ( $11^{\text {th }}$ or $12^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 semester
- Economics ( $11^{\text {th }}$ or $12^{\text {th }}$ grade) 1 semester
