



Math and Science Academy COVID-19 Exclusion Decision Tree

MSA will follow the appropriate path if a person is experiencing the following symptoms:

- **More common:** fever of 100.4 F or higher, new/worsening cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste/smell
- **Less common:** sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, chills, muscle pain, fatigue, feeling very tired, headache, congestion, runny nose

Definitions:

Isolation: After testing positive, or after the onset of symptoms if not tested, the individual must stay home for 10 days (for students) or 5 days (for staff).

Quarantine: After an exposure, individuals must stay home for a period of time (based on vaccination status and whether exposure was in the household). See [Close Contact Path](#).
